Link to **THE INTERNET** ...@ your library CAP site!

During this workshop library patrons will learn how to access and search online encyclopedias, government publications and databases that offer a wealth of current, authoritative and full text articles. Patrons will also be exposed to Southeast Regional Library's online catalogue as well as all public library holdings across Saskatchewan and the Saskatchewan Libraries: Ask Us! 24-hour online reference service.

This workshop will assist patrons in learning how to operate the basics in computer software. The operation of spreadsheets, word processing, internet browsers and e-mail programs will be presented in order to give patrons a fundamental understanding of the most utilized and practical programs available at their library.

This workshop will acquaint library patrons with Gateway, the online database that provides access to all the public library holdings across Saskatchewan. Patrons will learn how to search for items with Southeast Regional Library's collection as well as throughout the province for related or special materials.

This workshop will discuss some techniques for remaining "web aware." Patrons will learn how to determine the currency and safety of websites. Patrons will investigate some safe practices for online consumer practices and some policies regarding web safety in libraries.

In this workshop participants will learn how to evaluate the usefulness of websites for informational purposes. Techniques for assessing the currency, accuracy and depth of information on the web will be discussed. This workshop will hold a special appeal for students searching for online information or who are interested in homework assistance.

This workshop will aim to assist patrons in searching for genealogical information. The workshop will present techniques for searching for online information as well as how to search for print resources and other primary documents via the library.
